RHETORICAL MODES

Definition: The variety, conventions, and the purposes of the major writings.

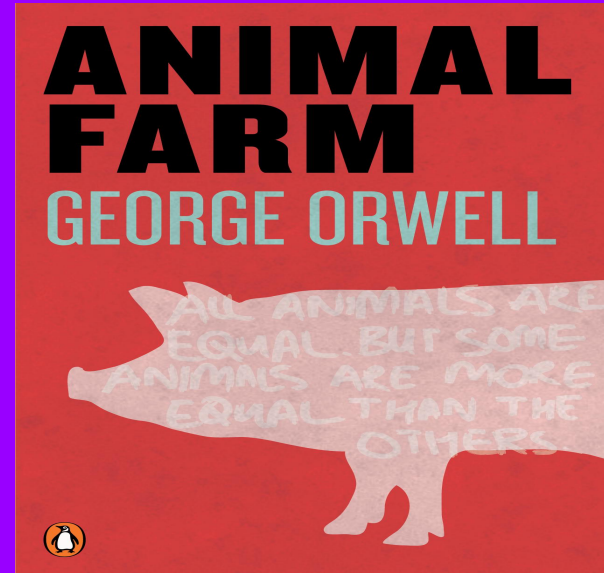
Examples are:

- ❑ Exposition
- ❑ Argumentation
- ❑ Description
- ❑ Narration

RHETORICAL MODE EXAMPLE

An example of rhetorical mode is narration.

An example of narration is “Animal Farm” by George Orwell because it is in third person narrative.

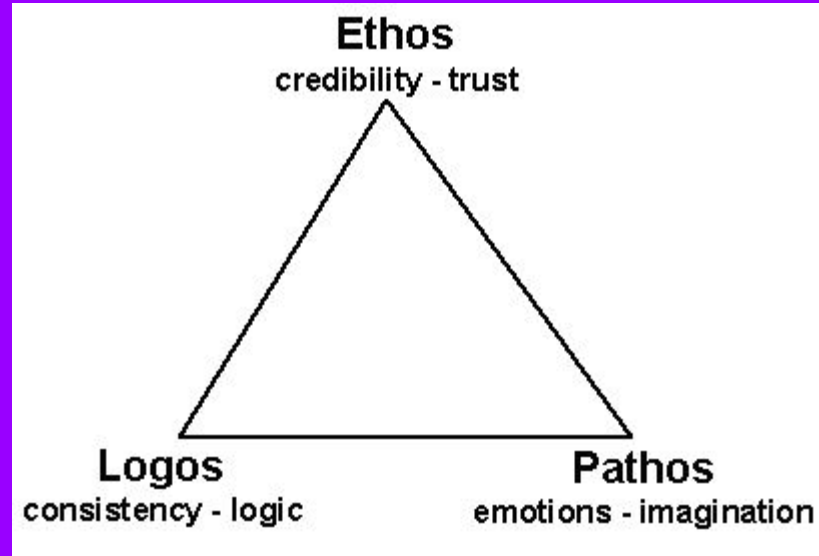


RHETORICAL STRATEGY

Definition: Plan of action to achieve a goal.

RHETORICAL DEVICES

Definition: Specific language tools used to carry out a rhetorical strategy.

Some examples are:

- ❑ Allusion
- ❑ Diction
- ❑ Imagery
- ❑ Syntax

RHETORICAL DEVICES EXAMPLE

In the Great Gatsby, by F. Scott Fitzgerald, “The interior was unprosperous and bare; the only car visible was the dust-covered wreck of a Ford which crouched in a dim corner”

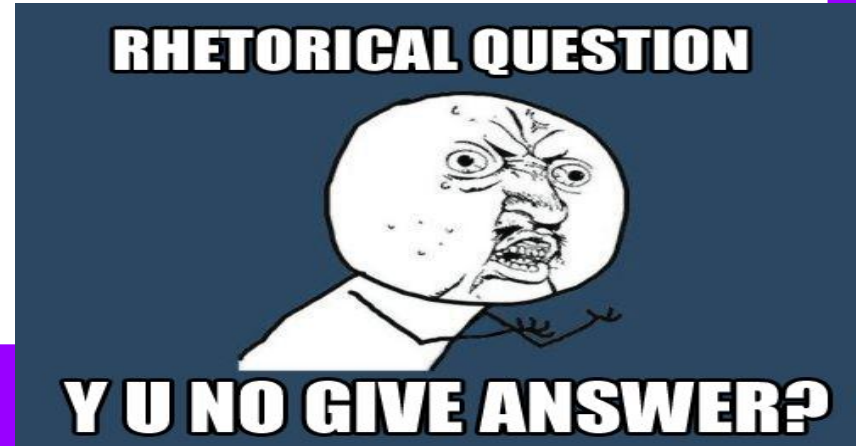


RHETORICAL QUESTION

Definition: Question in an argument with no direct answer.

RHETORICAL QUESTION EXAMPLE

- ❑ "Marriage is a wonderful institution, but *who would want to live in an institution?*" - H.L Mencken
- ❑ "Can I ask a rhetorical question? Well, can I?" - Ambrose Bierce
- ❑ "If practice makes perfect, and no one's perfect, then why practice?" - Billy Corgan
