FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE

Language that uses word or expressions with a meaning that is different from the literal interpretation

EXAMPLE OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE

They fought like cats and dogs (Simile)



FORESHADOWING

Purposeful hint placed in a work of literature to suggest what may occur later in the narrative

EXAMPLE OF FORESHADOWING

In the fairy tale, Little Red Riding Hood, the mother is concerned for her safety and that foreshadows the appearance of the big bad wolf




GENRE

The major category into which a literary work fits

EXAMPLE OF GENRE

The genre of Harper Lee's To Kill a Mockingbird is fiction




HYPERBOLE

figure of speech in which exaggeration is used to achieve emphasis
